

WALK IN INTERVIEW

Willing retired teachers (from Govt. / Govt. Aided Secondary Schools) and retired Govt. Employees are requested to appear before the selection committee with all original relevant documents along with two sets of attested xerox copies, at Regional Training Centre (above Treasury Building), Bankura for interview for the post of Guest Teachers and Gr-C & D staff respectively (details as mentioned below) on contractual basis for three English Medium Model Schools at Onda, Chhatna & Mejia Blocks.

Guest Teachers : One each for the following subject (for each Model School) :
Bengali, English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Life Science, History & Geography.
Teachers other than Bengali with English medium background will be given preference.

Date of Interview : 11/01/2013, Time : 11:00 A.M. to 03:00 P.M.

Non Teaching Staff : Group C – One(1), Group D – Two(2) for each Model School.

Date of Interview : 15/01/2013, Time : 11:00 A.M. to 03:00 P.M.

1. Eligibility :

- i) Only those teachers who have retired at the age of 60 years ROPA – 2009 scale as full time approved Govt. School Teacher and are below 64 years of age as on 01.01.2013 may apply for engagement as "Guest Teacher" in the Model School.
- ii) The retired Teacher / Lady Teacher should be physically fit and be mentally alert to discharge the duties of Guest Teacher in the school in which he / she would be engaged full time for 6 (six) days in a week during school hours and to perform related duties like invigilator, scrutiny of answer scripts of test, etc.
- iii) Teachers who have been made to retire compulsorily as punishment or voluntarily due to illness or for other type of incapacitation or have been charged / convicted of moral turpitude or for any criminal offence should not be considered for such engagement.
- iv) Retired Teachers from the Govt. Aided schools may be considered on adhoc basis if the required eligible retired Govt. School Teachers are not available.
- v) Preference will be given to Teachers who have retired from the schools within the concerned district.
- vi) Non-teaching staff should be engaged from retired Govt. employee.

2. Period of engagement :


The engagement should be up to six months or until regular teachers join the post in the schools whichever is earlier. No Guest Teacher/Non teaching staff will be allowed to continue beyond 65 years of age. Engagement may be renewable beyond six months if the regular teachers do not fill the post.

3. Remuneration :

The remuneration of the Guest teacher/Non teaching staff may be fixed as follows :
Basic Pay (including Grade Pay) on the date of superannuation plus dearness allowance admissible on the date of engagement in the re-employed service minus sum total of basic pension before commutation and dearness relief as admissible on basic pension on the date of engagement as a re-employed pensioner. He / She will draw pension relief on pension as usual.

N.B. :

1. No T.A. and D.A. will be allowed for the purpose of interview.
2. Willing candidates are requested to turn up with original and xerox copy of P.P.O. and residential certificate duly signed by Block Development Officer / Sub-Divisional Officer.
